Blasting at South Campus

As the South Campus Residence Hall Project is now underway, along Gilbert Road, there are areas where rock must be removed by blasting. Three whistles mean 5 minutes until the blast; two whistles mean 1 minute to blast; and one whistle means all clear to blast. Anyone in buildings near the construction zone may hear low rumbles from the rock blasting.

Veterans of the Month

Ryan Hinton & Jessika Gossett

The Office of Veterans Affairs & Military Programs (VAMP) at UConn is pleased to recognize Ryan Hinton & Jessika Gossett as UConn's Veterans of the Month. Both of them are new staff



members who are establishing and running the first Veterans Upward Bound Program in Connecticut. This program (hosted at UConn) will serve Veterans throughout the state who are first-generation, lowincome, or otherwise "at risk", guiding and supporting them throughout the process of applying to and attending college (any college).

Ryan Hinton, the Director of the Veterans Upward Bound Program, enlisted in the Army and reported to Basic Training three days after graduating from Saint Mary's University of Minnesota. After completing his initial enlistment, Ryan left active duty and joined the Army Reserves to pivot towards a career in education. While in the Reserves, Ryan Completed two Masters Degree programs in Education at the University of Notre Dame and worked as a teacher and then as a high school principal. Eventually, Ryan transferred out of the Reserves and into the CT Army National Guard where he served as the State Master Religious Affairs Noncommissioned Officer. In addition to his Chaplain Corps assignment, he volunteered to serve as the Education Services Officer for the CT Army National Guard, while that soldier was out on deployment. He retired after 22 years of combined service in December 2022. Ryan looks forward to serving our Veterans Community in succeeding in their educational aspirations.

Jessika Gossett is serving as the Academic Coordinator for Veterans Upward Bound. She is a U.S. Marine who served eight years as an Intelligence Specialist. She holds a Bachelor's in Political Science and Psychology and is pursuing her master's degree in Organizational Psychology with the University of Hartford. As a first-generation college student, Jessika understands the unique challenges that face veterans and first-generation college students. Before coming on board with Veterans Upward Bound, Jessika served veterans and their families by volunteering with different Veteran Service Officers. Jessika is excited to be on the UConn team and remains dedicated to ensuring all veterans get the most out of their benefits.
