

Veteran of the Month

Rhiannon Trunzo

The Office of Veterans Affairs & Military Programs (VAMP) at UConn is pleased to recognize Rhiannon Trunzo as UConn's Veteran of the Month. Rhiannon is a UConn student who is part of the VA Work Study



team. In addition to being a UConn student, Rhiannon also serves in the National Guard. She originally enlisted as a flute player in the Rhode Island National Guard 88th Army Band in April 2021, then transferred to the 102d CT Army National Guard Band to come to UConn in September 2022. This past summer she went TDY to support the 323d Army Band at Fort Sam Houston, which was an incredible experience for Rhiannon, especially playing at the Armed Forces River Parade with IET soldiers in uniform singing their branch's songs as military barges floated by. She says she also "learned a great amount about leadership and camaraderie at the Basic Leader Course at Fort Indiantown Gap, which was a great step forward in my military career."

Rhiannon is a Psych Major/Neuroscience minor, and she has a long-term goal of getting a doctorate degree in clinical psychology and becoming a practicing clinical psychologist. At UConn, Rhiannon loves working in the office, participating in the weekly game day, and she especially loves the Dungeons and Dragons nights! Rhiannon says "There's also a lot of really valuable research opportunities, the Psychology department is top tier and I'm excited to learn as much as I can from hands-on experience."

Rhiannon shares "as a military student, being well connected with the VAMP office and Veteran Student Organization is really helpful and important. Taking the FYE course (which I'm looking forward to mentoring this semester) going to VSO events, and making sure your benefit process is going smoothly can ease a lot of academic and financial stress while finding a strong social support system."
