Veteran of the Month

John Albanese

The Office of Veterans Affairs & Military Programs (VAMP) at UConn is pleased to recognize John Albanese as UConn's Veteran of the Month. John is a UConn Alum (he received his MBA in 2006) and is currently



at Voya. In his free time he's been raising and and training a puppy, Cooper, for America's Vet Dogs, who will go to a Veteran in need of a service dog. John was honored on the field at the UConn Military Appreciation Game in September (pictured with Cooper and Jonathan). John served in the military, enlisting in the Marine Corps and going off to boot camp a week after graduating high school. He served in the military for 5 years. One of his first and most memorable deployments as a marine was to Washington, DC where he was selected for a prestigious assignment with the Presidential Honor Guard at the "Oldest Post of the Corps," Marine Barracks, 8th & I. While there he was assigned to various details attended by the President and various Heads of State at the White House, Pentagon, Arlington National Cemetery, and other locations throughout the U.S. He has also served with a Weapons Platoon out of Camp Pendleton and deployed to the Western Pacific. He was also recalled to active duty with a Casualty Replacement Battalion and trained for deployment overseas in support of Operation Desert Storm, but the ground war ended after six weeks and they were no longer needed. So, he returned to civilian life.

Still seeking the camaraderie experienced in the military but without the deployments, John shifted to a career in law enforcement for a twenty-year period with the Connecticut State Police. Throughout his law enforcement career, he pursued higher education, earning an MBA from the University of Connecticut. Upon leaving law enforcement, John started working with USAA, an organization known for hiring and serving the military community. Several years later in 2015, he was hired at Voya where he continues to oversee the Corporate Security and Investigations team.
