## **Veteran of the Month**

### **Jahmir Roy**

UConn's Veterans and
Military Programs is pleased
to recognize Jahmir Roy as
UConn's Veteran of the Month.
Jahmir is currently an
undergraduate student at
UConn and assists fellow
students in the main office of
Hawley Armory via the VA Work



Study program. He also recently shared his story with the State Legislature during their budget hearings in order to support UConn. Jahmir served 8 years in the Navy as an Electronics Technician Nuclear, which meant that he was responsible for the maintenance and operation of the Nuclear Reactor instrumentation and control equipment. The US Navy uses nuclear reactors to provide electrical power and propulsion for submarines and aircraft carriers. During that time, Jahmir shares his most memorable time was going to see the ball drop in NYC with his best friend: "we both wore our navy blue service dress uniforms and were escorted by NYPD to Times Square where we had front row seats to the countdown.

Jahmir's goals at UConn are to graduate with a degree in psychology and philosophy, and then pursue either a doctorate in psychology or go to law school, with the ultimate intent of helping children in bad situations. He says he enjoys being back in school and learning things in a formal setting, something that he's missed dearly since graduating high school.

Jahmir's advice to other students is: "Be sure to reach out to the VAMP (Veterans & Military Programs) team. There's a lot of great people with experience and knowledge that is invaluable for our community. Also don't be afraid to get the help you need to succeed, especially in the case of mental health. Too many of us suffer in silence and don't reach out until it's too late. We're all in this together, no on is alone."
