

Genesis Latorre-Valentin

The Office of Veterans & Military Programs (VAMP) at UConn is pleased to recognize Genesis Latorre-Valentin as UConn's Veteran of the Month. Genesis is currently a student at the UConn Hartford campus and a member of the CT National Guard while pursuing a Bachelors degree in Communication. She is also the recipient of the Kyle Milliken Scholarship.

Genesis has been serving in the CT Army National Guard as a Human Resources Sergeant for the Junior Enlisted Council (JEC).

The JEC was formed in June 2023 and represents all junior enlisted personnel (E-1 to E-6). They talk about any issues that affect their experience in the Guard, both in their jobs and personal lives. In her role with JEC, she strives to connect with the military community with the planning and organization of welfare and morale-related projects for enlisted personnel.

Her main goal as a student at UConn is to get her college degree while balancing her personal life and professional career. She advises other military and veteran students: "while having the college experience is tough, it's of course super rewarding... But don't forget to take some time to relax and enjoy life outside of college.
